

**ALL-SPORTS TROPHY**

1. Purpose
  - A. To increase the interest and the number of students participating in the Intercollegiate Athletic Program of the members of the Michigan Community College Athletic Association.
  - B. To increase the number of sports and to widen the range of athletic activities within the membership of the Michigan Community College Athletic Association.
2. Sports include all those sponsored by the MCCA which as of this date are: Baseball (M), Basketball (M) (W), Golf (M), Cross Country (M) (W), Softball (W), Volleyball (W), Soccer (M) (W).
3. Ranking in each sport shall depend only upon competition between members of the Michigan Community College Athletic Association. Calculation will only be made for those members who sponsor five (5) or more sports.
4. Additional sports may be added when the majority of the colleges signify their desire to sanction such competition.
5. When an MCCA Championship tournament is held, the winner will receive a “bonus” number of points equal to the number of MCCA schools that filed eligibility for that sport. The Runner-up in that tournament will receive half that number of points.
6. The trophy is to be presented at the end of the college year to the member earning the highest average number of points based on the system

## The system (Conference Champion Points)

- A. Men’s and Women’s Basketball (100 East/100 West) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. For example, 10 teams = 10 point increments; 9 teams = 11.1 point increments, etc. A bonus of one point per participating school – currently 19 – to the MCCA Tournament winner. A bonus of one-half point per participating school to the MCCA Tournament runner –up.
- B. Volleyball (100 East/100 West) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. A bonus of one point per participating school – currently 17 – to the MCCA Tournament winner. A bonus of one-half point per participating schools to the MCCA Tournament runner-up.
- C. Softball (100 East/100 West) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. A bonus of one point per participating school – currently 17 – to the MCCA Tournament winner. A bonus of one-half point per participating school to the MCCA Tournament runner-up

**ALL-SPORTS TROPHY (Continued)**

- D. Golf (100 East/100 West) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. A bonus of one point per participating school – currently 13 – to the MCCA Tournament winner. A bonus of one-half point per participating school to the MCCA Tournament runner-up.
- E. Baseball (100 MCCA) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. For example 13 teams = 7.69 point increments
- F. Soccer (100 MCCA) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. For example, 4 teams = 25 points or 5 teams = 20 points.
- G. Men's and Women's Cross Country (100 MCCA) with each decreasing position getting the number of points less as determined by dividing 100 by the number of participating schools. For example, 5 teams = 20 point increments; 6 teams = 16.7 point increments. A bonus of one point per participating school – currently 7 teams for men, 7 teams of women – to the MCCA Tournament winner. A bonus of one-half point per participating school to the MCCA Tournament runner-up.
- H. All points are added together and averaged by the number of MCCA sanctioned sports a school offers, giving each school an average point total that will be used to rank the schools.
6. The trophy shall be engraved with the name of the winning college in whose possession it shall remain until such time as it is won by another Association member.
7. A member's All-Sports points will be determined by its competitive rankings as follows:

8. Teams not completing the conference schedule will not receive All-Sports points for that sport.
