

AWARDS

1. The Association will provide awards for sponsored sports as designated below.
2. Association awards given to contestants shall be paid for by the association.
3. Association awards shall be paid for from fees assessed to members declaring MCCAAs sports, at the Spring Legislative Assembly.
4. The Secretary shall order all awards and trophies presented by the MCCAAs.
5. Where NJCAA dictates a team size that number will dictate the number of awards given to the Championship team
6. In a sport where a MCCAAs Champion is crowned, if there are less than six competing members only a MCCAAs Championship plaque will be awarded. If there are more than six competing members, a runner-up trophy will be awarded. In sports divided by conferences, Conference champion plaques will be awarded to the conference champions. In case of a tie for a conference championship, plaques will be awarded to all those who are tied. If a sport has less than six competing members then there will only be six All-MCCAAs awards in that sport unless approved by the legislative assembly.

MCCAA Academic Team Award.

Presented to each team with a team GPA of 3.0 or higher

Eligible Team(s):

- Each student/athlete listed on the team eligibility form that finishes the season with the team shall be used to figure the team's overall Grade Point Average. All course hours attempted must be included. The team's minimum **GPA** submitted will be a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- All academic work attempted shall be used including transfer credit, remedial/developmental courses including hours earned at a previous college.
- Must be a full team roster in order to submit (*Ex. Golf team must have minimum 4 team members*)
- Last academic year of work must be taken at the MCCAA Conference School represented by the athlete
- Team must have participated in an MCCAA sponsored sport sanctioned by the NJCAA at the varsity level at the college from which he/she is nominated.

Application Process:

- The College Athletic Director shall be responsible to submit team and players with Grade Point Averages and documentation* by the 15th of June to MCCAA Publicity Director. All hours need to be computed including "F"s.
