

VOLLEYBALL

1. The NJCAA Code of Conduct (Article XX) and the NJCAA Sportsmanship Policy (Article XVIII) will apply to all MCCAAs Contests.
2. Statistics
 - A. Statistics for **ALL** games played prior to one week before voting must be entered and up to date on the NJCAA website (or website designated by the NJCAA) for players to be eligible for MCCAAs Post-Season awards.
 1. Statistics must be up to date for **ALL** players not just players nominated for awards.
 2. It is the job of each athletic director with the assistance of the volleyball sport chairs to ensure stats are kept up to date through out the season.
3. Conference schedules should be drawn in advance. The schedule of team number is:

4. The Association is divided into Eastern and Western Conferences. Each conference will crown a champion based on a won/lost percentage of a double round robin schedule. Co-Champions will be recognized in case of a tie.
5. Conference matches will consist of 3 out of 5 games.
6. All matches are to be played in accordance with NCAA volleyball rules.
7. The official volleyball shall be an 18 panel ball of top quality soft leather such as the Tachikara SV-5W or Mikasa Competition 200. The Mikasa VL200 is not acceptable.
8. The playing court shall be available for volleyball matches 30 minutes prior to the starting time. A warm-up area is to be available 45 minutes prior to the start of the match.
9. Each member schools shall turn in to the MCCAAs Information Director the following information by the deadline indicated
 - A. By August 1st an accurate schedule with any last minute changes. Please update changes

- B. A roster with Number, Name, Position, Height, Year, Hometown and High School is due one week prior to the first contest.
 - C. A digital team picture as soon as possible after the start of the season.
10. By September of each year information regarding MCCAAs contests will be available to officials and visiting teams on the www.mccaa.org web site. This information will include, but not be limited to:
- A. Date and time of games
 - B. Location of games.
11. Information such as directions to the site of contest uniform color (for tournaments), and available eating and lodging establishments should be requested from the host school whenever necessary.
12. The officials will be NCAA or PAVO rated and may not be students or employees or any MCCAAs member school offering Volleyball as a varsity sport.
- The Director of Officials will assign officials to all games that involve MCCAAs members and shall receive the schedules by June 1st of each year.
13. Each school should provide trained scorers and line persons for their matches.
14. Each conference will select six players to be named All-MCCAAs.
15. All home games will be at 7:00 PM in the Eastern Conference and 6:30 PM in the Western Conference.
16. Awards

A. Eastern Conference

- 1. Each school may submit up to five players for All-Conference Honors. Stats will be taken off the NJCAA Web Site.
- 2. Each coach will vote for 18 players ranking those players from best (1st) to 18th with the best receiving 18 points and so on down to 1 for 18th place. Coaches may not vote for their own players. They will also vote for coach of the year.
- 3. The top six vote getters will be All-Region, All-MCCAAs and First Team All-Conference.
- 4. The next six vote getters will be Second Team All-Conference
- 5. The next six vote getters will be Third Team All-Conference
- 6. The rest will be Honorable Mention All-Conference

VOLLEYBALL (Continued)

7. The top six freshman vote getters will be on the All-Freshman Team
- B. Western Conference
 1. Each coach may nominate up to three players with an option to nominate fourth if they are the first place team and they go undefeated through the conference schedule. Conference statistics will be used for the voting.
 - A. Coaches will vote for 12 players and may not vote for their own players.
 - B. First six vote getters will be All-MCCAA and First Team All-Conference. The top five vote getters will also be All-Region XII
 - C. The next six vote getters will be Second Team All-Conference.
 - D. All others will be honorable Mention.
 - E. The top six freshman vote getters will be named to the All-Freshman Team
 - F. Coaches will vote for coach of the year at this time as well.
17. Each Conference will determine their respective "Coach of the Year". The volleyball "Coach of the Year" of the MCCAA will be the champion of the MCCAA Tournament.
18. **MCCAA TOURNAMENT**
 - A. Tournament format
 1. Top (4) four teams from each conference (as decided by Regional seeding)
 2. The MCCAA Tournament to be held the week-end before the NJCAA district tournament at a site determined by bid.
 3. (1) One site, (2) two days, single elimination.
 4. The quarterfinals will take place on Friday with the 2nd place team for the Eastern Conference playing the 3rd place team from the Western Conference and the 2nd place Western Conference Team playing the 3rd place Eastern Conference Team. These games will take place Friday at 4:00 PM. The other quarterfinal matches, 1st Place Eastern Conference versus 4th Place Western Conference and 1st Place Western Conference versus the 4th Place Eastern Conference school will take place no earlier than 6:00 PM and will have at least 20 minutes down time between matches.

VOLLEYBALL (CONT)

The semi-finals will take place Saturday at 11:00 AM with the winner of 1st Place Eastern versus 4th Place Western playing the winner of 2nd Place Western versus 3rd Place Eastern. The other semi-final will have the winner of 1st Place Western versus 4th Place Eastern playing the winner of 2nd Place Eastern versus 3rd Place Western.

The Championship match will take place no earlier than 2:00 PM and will have a mandatory down time of 20 minutes between the match and warm up. All matches will be given a minimum of 30 minutes of warm up time.

5. All matches are to be played in accordance with NCAA rules
 6. Beginning in 2009, all line judges for the MCCA tournament will be certified line judges.
- B. Results do not affect seeding for Region XII Tournament.

- D. The coach of the tournament champions will be MCCA coach of the year
